Matthew 8:27 TLB

The disciples just sat there, **awed!** "Who is this," they asked themselves, "that even the winds and the sea obey him?"

Matthew 9:8 AMP

When the crowds saw this, they were **awestruck**, and glorified God and praised Him, who had given such authority and power to men.

Matthew 14:33 AMP

Then those in the boat worshiped Him [with **awe**-inspired reverence], saying, "Truly You are the Son of God!"

Matthew 17:6 CEB

Hearing this, the disciples fell on their faces, filled with **awe**.

Matthew 27:54 AMP

Now the centurion, and those who were with him keeping guard over Jesus, when they saw the earthquake and the things that were happening, they were terribly frightened and filled with **awe**, and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"

Mark 4:41 CEB

Overcome with **awe**, they said to each other, "Who then is this? Even the wind and the sea obey him!"

Mark 5:15 CEB

They came to Jesus and saw the man who used to be demon-possessed. They saw the very man who had been filled with many demons sitting there fully dressed and completely sane, and they were filled with **awe**.

Mark 5:20 TLB

So the man started off to visit the Ten Towns of that region and began to tell everyone about the great things Jesus had done for him; and they were **awestruck** by his story.

Mark 6:20 HCSB

because Herod was in **awe** of John and was protecting him, knowing he was a righteous and holy man. When Herod heard him he would be very disturbed, yet would hear him gladly.

Mark 9:15 BSB

As soon as all the people saw Jesus, they were filled with **awe** and ran to greet Him.

Mark 13:1 CEB

As Jesus left the temple, one of his disciples said to him, "Teacher, look! What **awesome** stones and buildings!"

Luke 1:50 AMP

AND HIS MERCY IS UPON GENERATION AFTER GENERATION TOWARD THOSE WHO [stand in great **awe** of God and] FEAR HIM.

Luke 1:65 BSB

All their neighbors were filled with **awe**, and people throughout the hill country of Judea were talking about these events.

Luke 4:22 AMP

And [as He continued on] they all were speaking well of Him, and were in **awe** and were wondering about the words of grace which were coming from His lips; and they were saying, "Is this not Joseph's son?"

Luke 4:36 AMP

They were all astonished and in **awe**, and began saying to one another, "What is this message? For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits and they come out!"

Luke 5:9 TLB

For he was **awe**struck by the size of their catch, as were the others with him,

Luke 5:26 BSB

Everyone was taken with amazement and glorified God. They were filled with **awe** and said, "We have seen remarkable things today."

Luke 7:16 AMP

Fear and profound **awe** gripped them all, and they began glorifying and honoring and praising God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and, "God has visited His people [to help and care for and provide for them]!"

Luke 8:25 CEB

He said to his disciples, "Where is your faith?" Filled with **awe** and wonder, they said to each other, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him!"

Luke 8:35 CEB

People came to see what had happened. They came to Jesus and found the man from whom the demons had gone. He was sitting at Jesus' feet, fully dressed and completely sane. They were filled with **awe**.

Luke 9:34 CEB

Peter was still speaking when a cloud overshadowed them. As they entered the cloud, they were overcome with **awe**.

Luke 9:43 AMP

They were all amazed [practically overwhelmed] at the [evidence of the] greatness of God and His majesty and His wondrous work. But while they were still **awed** by everything Jesus was doing, He said to His disciples,

Luke 11:14 AMP

And [at another time] Jesus was casting out a demon, and it was [controlling a man so as to make him] mute; when the demon had gone out, the mute man spoke. And the crowds were **awed**.

Luke 11:44 TLB

Yes, **awesome** judgment is awaiting you. For you are like hidden graves in a field. Men go by you with no knowledge of the corruption they are passing."

Luke 12:5 AMP

But I will point out to you whom you should fear: fear the One who, after He has killed, has authority and power to hurl [you] into hell; yes, I say to you, [stand in great **awe** of God and] fear Him!

Luke 23:47 TLB

When the captain of the Roman military unit handling the executions saw what had happened, he was stricken with **awe** before God and said, "Surely this man was innocent."

John 1:18 AMP

No one has seen God [His essence, His divine nature] at any time; the [One and] only begotten God [that is, the unique Son] who is in the intimate presence of the Father, He has explained Him [and interpreted and revealed the **awesome** wonder of the Father].

John 5:20 TLB

For the Father loves the Son, and tells him everything he is doing; and the Son will do far more **awesome** miracles than this man's healing.

John 9:38 AMP

And he said, "Lord, I believe [in You and Your word]!" And he worshiped Him [with reverence and **awe**].

Acts 2:20 LSB

THE SUN WILL BE TURNED INTO DARKNESS AND THE MOON INTO BLOOD, BEFORE THE GREAT AND **AWESOME** DAY OF THE LORD COMES.

Acts 2:43 AMP

A sense of **awe** was felt by everyone, and many wonders and signs (attesting miracles) were taking place through the apostles.

Acts 3:10 HCSB

and they recognized that he was the one who used to sit and beg at the Beautiful Gate of the temple complex. So they were filled with **awe** and astonishment at what had happened to him.

Acts 3:11 TLB

They all rushed out to Solomon's Hall, where he was holding tightly to Peter and John! Everyone stood there **awed** by the wonderful thing that had happened.

Acts 5:5 AMP

And hearing these words, Ananias fell down suddenly and died; and great fear and **awe** gripped those who heard of it.

Acts 5:11 AMP

And great fear and **awe** gripped the whole church, and all who heard about these things.

Acts 20:10 TLB

Paul went down and took him into his arms. "Don't worry," he said, "he's all right!" And he was! What a wave of **awesome** joy swept through the crowd! They all went back upstairs and ate the Lord's Supper together; then Paul preached another long sermon-so it was dawn when he finally left them!

Romans 3:18 AMP

"THERE IS NO FEAR OF GOD [and His **awesome** power] BEFORE THEIR EYES."

Romans 9:17 TLB

Pharaoh, king of Egypt, was an example of this fact. For God told him he had given him the kingdom of Egypt for the very purpose of displaying the **awesome** power of God against him, so that all the world would hear about God's glorious name.

Romans 11:20 AMP

That is true. They were broken off because of their unbelief, but you stand by your faith [as believers understanding the truth of Christ's deity]. Do not be conceited, but [rather stand in great **awe** of God and] fear [Him];

1 Corinthians 8:3 AMP

But if anyone loves God [with **awe**-filled reverence, obedience and gratitude], he is known by Him [as His very own and is greatly loved].

2 Corinthians 4:7 CEB

But we have this treasure in clay pots so that the **awesome** power belongs to God and doesn't come from us.

Philippians 2:12 AMP

So then, my dear ones, just as you have always obeyed [my instructions with enthusiasm], not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence, continue to work out your salvation [that is, cultivate it, bring it to full effect, actively pursue spiritual maturity] with **awe**-inspired fear and trembling [using serious caution and critical self-evaluation to avoid anything that might offend God or discredit the name of Christ].

Hebrews 1:3 AMP

The Son is the radiance and only expression of the glory of [our **awesome**] God [reflecting God's Shekinah glory, the Light-being, the brilliant light of the divine], and the exact representation and perfect imprint of His [Father's] essence, and upholding and maintaining and propelling all things [the entire physical and spiritual universe] by His powerful word [carrying the universe along to its predetermined goal]. When He [Himself and no other] had [by offering Himself on the cross as a sacrifice for sin] accomplished purification from sins and established our freedom from guilt, He sat down [revealing His completed work] at the right hand of the Majesty on high [revealing His Divine authority],

Hebrews 12:19 TLB

For there was an **awesome** trumpet blast and a voice with a message so terrible that the people begged God to stop speaking.

Hebrews 12:28 AMP

Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, and offer to God pleasing service and acceptable worship with reverence and **awe**;

James 2:19 AMP

You believe that God is one; you do well [to believe that]. The demons also believe [that], and shudder and bristle [in **awe**-filled terror—they have seen His wrath]!

2 Peter 3:11 AMP

Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be [in the meantime] in holy behavior [that is, in a pattern of daily life that sets you apart as a believer] and in godliness [displaying profound reverence toward our **awesome** God],

Revelation 8:1 AMP

When He (the Lamb) broke open the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour [in **awe** of God's impending judgment].

Revelation 10:3 AMP

and he shouted with a loud voice, like the roaring of a lion [compelling attention and inspiring **awe**]; and when he had shouted out, the seven peals of thunder spoke with their own voices [uttering their message in distinct words].

Revelation 11:13 AMP

And in that [very] hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell and was destroyed; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest [who survived] were overcome with terror, and they glorified the God of heaven [as they recognized His **awesome** power].

Revelation 13:3 TLB

I saw that one of his heads seemed wounded beyond recovery—but the fatal wound was healed! All the world marveled at this miracle and followed the Creature in **awe**.

Revelation 13:13 AMP

He performs great signs (**awe**-inspiring acts), even making fire fall from the sky to the earth, right before peoples' eyes.

Revelation 14:7 AMP

and he said with a loud voice, "Fear God [with **awe** and reverence], and give Him glory [and honor and praise in worship], because the hour of His judgment has come; [with all your heart] worship Him who created the heaven and the earth, the sea and the springs of water."

Revelation 15:1 CEB

Then I saw another great and **awe**-inspiring sign in heaven. There were seven angels

with seven plagues—and these are the last, for with them God’s anger is brought to an end.

Revelation 15:3 AMP

And they sang the song of Moses, the bond-servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, “Great and wonderful and **awe**-inspiring are Your works [in judgment], O Lord God, the Almighty [the Omnipotent, the Ruler of all]; Righteous and true are Your ways, O King of the nations!

Revelation 22:3 AMP

There will no longer exist anything that is cursed [because sin and illness and death are gone]; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His bond-servants will serve and worship Him [with great **awe** and joy and loving devotion];
