GOD IS WORKING IN ADJUMANI

I received some encouraging news from our co-worker in Adjumani. I thought you might like to hear from Pastor David as well: "We had a wonderful training this time. 52 students attended and 51 managed to sit for the tests. There's been strong signs of learning and growth among the students. We received 4 new ones.

At the end of the training, we introduced a plan to split the students into several groups depending on their places of residence, so that they can build up teams to conduct outreach programs among themselves while on leave from training, with the help of their pastors hosting such programs in their church. We'll also join them as they undertake such programs.

The first one was done at pastor Godfrey's church where 9 got saved 4 revived back to the Lord. We moved home to home during the day and preached at the church compound in the evening. 7 of the students in that group all came. It was so refreshing. Next is at a new Sub-County where a church has never been planted before. Lord willing, we shall have a church there. Our plan is to have one strong central church planted in each of the eleven sub-counties of Adjumani disteict that can be a mother church for the other churches that shall eventually be planted. And this will continue and rotate among the groups. Be praying for us!!!"

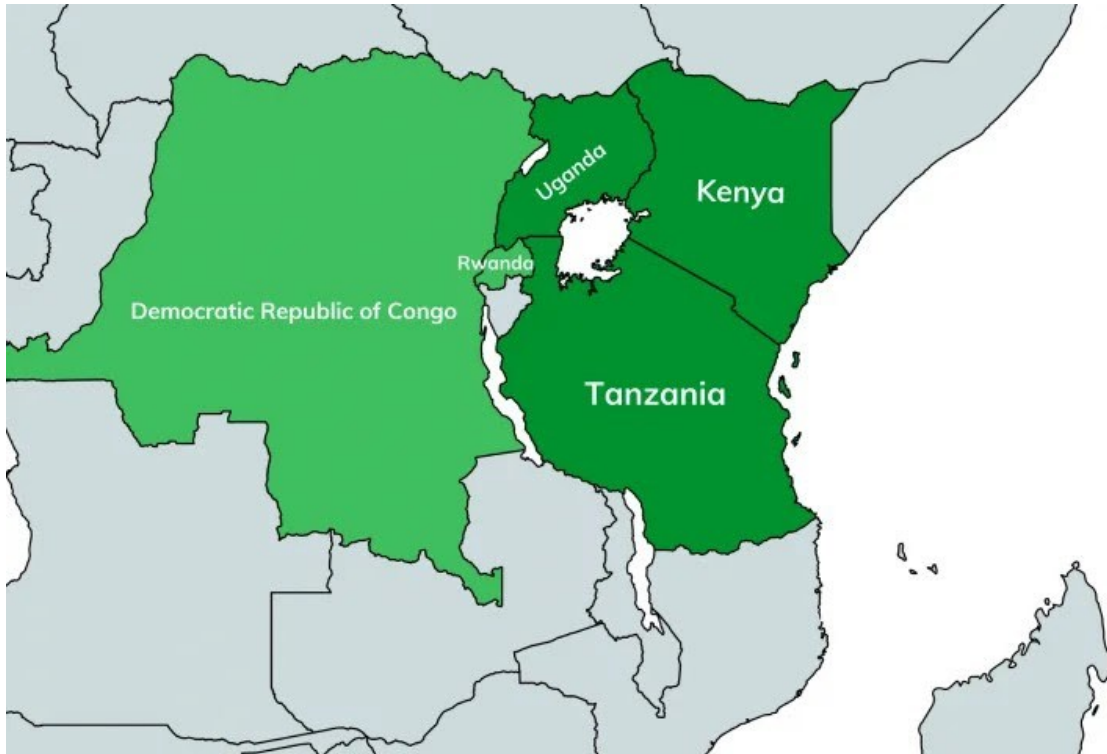


KISWAHILI IS PRINTED!

I'm so thankful for a fellow missionary in Kenya, Aaron Simonsen, who helped with this project. Swahili is the *lingua franca* of East Africa with well over 100 million speaking it as their mother language. Although the larger number live in Tanzania and Kenya, there are about 5 million people who speak it fluently in Uganda. Please pray for this translation of "Wise unto Salvation" that it will reach many people in the language they understand best.



The Maasai are a tribal group of people in Kenya numbering about 1.5 million. Along with their native language, Maa, they also speak Swahili. Currently, there are about 30,000 Maasai in Uganda. They are very easy to spot because of their distinctive red plaid clothes and usually they sell sandals. My friend, Taylor Rains, pointed them out to me when he visited us in Uganda. I've always wanted to give them some Gospel literature in their own language, and now I can!!! Will you take a few minutes today to pray for the Maasai and for the Swahili-speaking world of East Africa?
