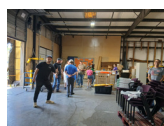

READING INTERVENTIONS

More students than ever are struggling with foundational reading skills at Nueva Esperanza, creating an urgent need for individualized support and instruction. In God's timing, Carlos & Barbara's daughter, Amanda temporarily moved back to Honduras in September to serve at Nueva Esperanza.



Over the past several months, Amanda has stepped into multiple roles to help meet the ministry's growing needs. During Liz Lopez's maternity leave, she assisted by translating letters. At the same time, she began working directly with students who were struggling most with reading. She currently works with twelve students, ranging from second through seventh grade.

Through methods grounded in the science of reading, the students are receiving phonics instruction and building reading fluency. What was once a storage room has now been transformed into a small reading intervention classroom where students who are behind receive personalized instruction, encouragement, and the extra support they need to succeed. It has become a place of growth and confidence for many students who were falling behind.

Amanda has shared how meaningful it has been to put into practice everything she has been studying. She is grateful to once again be involved and encouraged by the growth she has witnessed at Nueva Esperanza after having been away from the ministry for ten years. It has been a blessing to see how the ministry continues to expand its impact in the lives of students and families, and Amanda is thankful to play a small part in helping children discover the joy and ability to read.

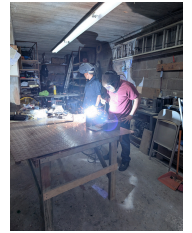

CAREER CLASSES

As we are continually growing our youth ministry and starting to integrate our Career & Training Center programs, we have started offering our Introductory Career Classes to the 9th - 12th graders. So far this year we have offered Health, Culinary Arts, Home Economics, Masonry, Cosmetology, Computer Networking, Welding, Business English, Automotive Painting, and Early Childhood Education.
