# SUNDAY SCHOOL SPOTLIGHT

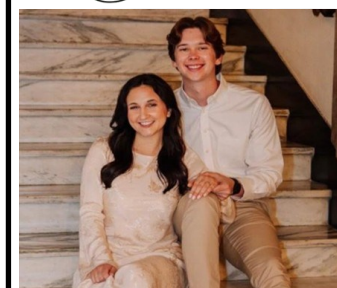
