God wants believers to have assurance of their salvation.

1 John 5:11-13

¹¹ And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. ¹² He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

¹³ I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

Romans 8:1

¹ Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus...

Salvation rests on Christ's work on the cross, not on our performance.

Romans 5:1-2

¹ Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. ² through whom we have gained access by faith into the grace in which we now stand.

The question is not, "Have you achieved perfection?"

¹³ But encourage one another daily, as long as it is still called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. ¹⁴ We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly till the end the confidence we had at first.
