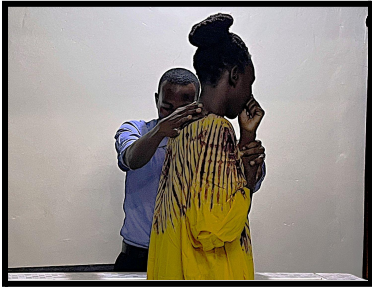


The Dye's in UGANDA
