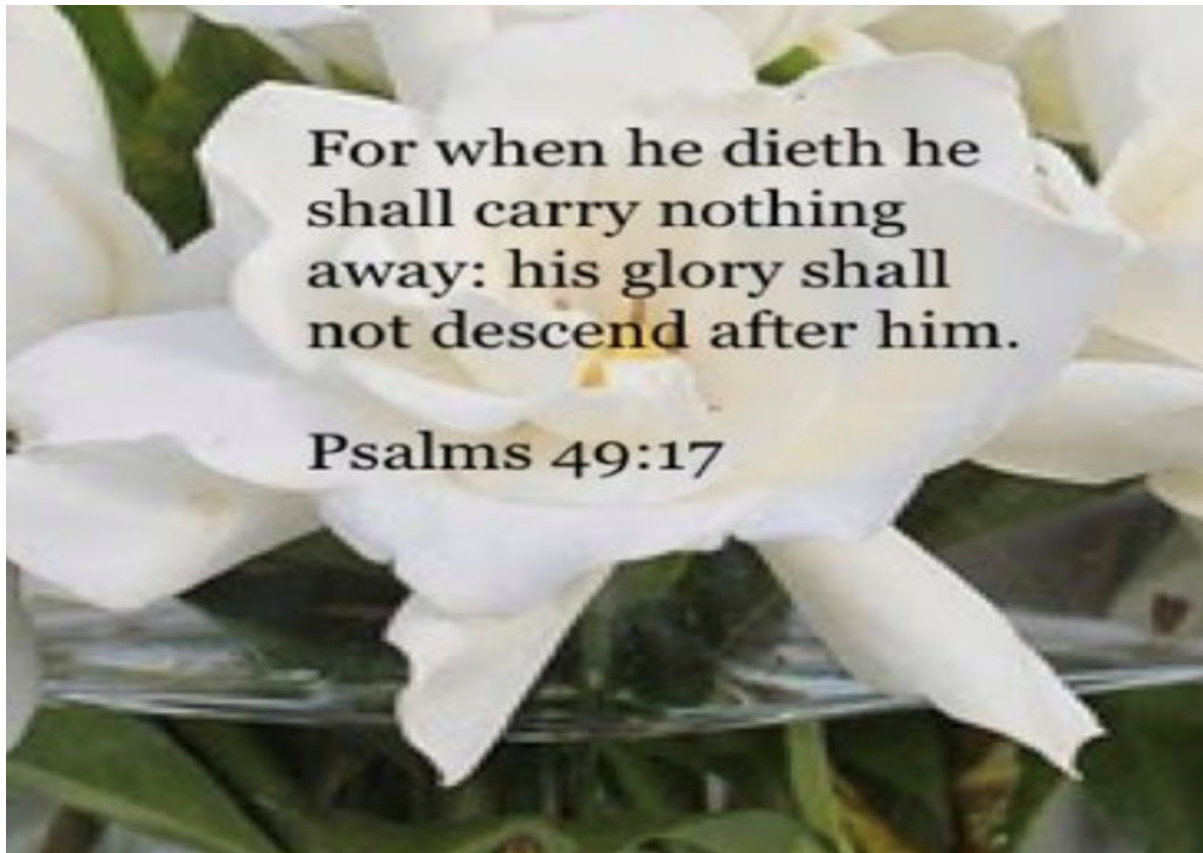

“Thoughts To Ponder”

“Riches”

Psalms 49:17 For when he dieth he shall carry nothing away: his glory shall not descend after him.

Many of us in wealthy countries know little about severe poverty. We've been so prosperous for so long that we can scarcely imagine times being any different. I have traveled to six out of the seven continents in my lifetime. I've been in some Third World countries that made me very aware of real poverty. Psalm 49 describes people who think their wealth will last forever; but in a short time ... they will die, and their possessions they worked so hard to obtain ... will be left to others. God is not concerned about how many material things we have as he is about our attitude toward our possessions. Money is not the root of all evil ... It is the love of Money.


We need to remember that God has given us the power to work and get wealth ... and that he can take it away at any time. Isaiah 40:17 says, All nations before him are as nothing; and they are counted to him less than nothing, and vanity. God has allowed us to experience a long period of peace and prosperity ... but it would be very easy for Him to let this come to a sudden end.

In Daniel, four, we read of King Nebuchadnezzar, who thought he was invincible. While he was praising himself for all his great works, a voice came from heaven, saying his kingdom had departed ... he would be driven away from men ... and he would eat grass like an ox. In that same hour these things started to happen.


The rich man described in Luke 12 thought he could sit back and take it easy for many years. He told himself to eat, drink and be merry. But God said, thou fool this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou has provided? (Luke 12:19-20).

Matthew 6:19-20 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Instead of trusting in ourselves and our riches, let's invest our time, talents, and wealth in God's Kingdom, where we can be assured they are safe forever.
