

# Board Meeting Summary

May 26, 2026

The meeting opened with a devotional from Pastor Lee on Acts 27:13–44, emphasizing how God uses life's storms for His purposes and protection. A time of prayer followed, focusing on the Senior Pastor Search Committee, pastoral transitions, Matthew's new role, ESL ministry needs, upcoming surgeries, bereavement, and various congregational concerns.

The Board approved the amended April 28, 2026 minutes. Under business arising, plans were confirmed for the May 31 farewell celebration for Interim Senior Pastor Doug Green. The Senior Pastor Search Committee reported that the interview process will begin in June. Membership interviews were nearly completed, with new members to be welcomed on June 14.

Interim Senior Pastor Tom Mei begins his role on June 1 and will integrate into staff routines with support from Lulu. Summer Ministry Assistant Matthew Ferrer continues to take on increasing responsibilities through the summer.

The Board received and accepted the April 2026 financial report presented by Treasurer Ferdie Cabida.

New business included a request for a second weekly pickleball night. After discussion, the Board recommended keeping Thursday evenings available for other ministries and suggested extending Wednesday sessions or using outdoor space. ESL will host volunteer-recruitment tables in the gym this summer. Regarding Canada Day, the Board affirmed that personal invitations and the signboard remain the most effective ways to engage neighbours.

Reports from Stewardship and Daycare committees highlighted facility updates, roof quotes, and successful daycare gymnastics programming. Pastors submitted written reports noting encouraging developments in children's, youth, young adult, and worship ministries. Ongoing issues with the lounge audio system and wireless reliability will be addressed through contractor follow-up and improved communication with ministry users.

The meeting closed in prayer, with the next Board meeting scheduled for June 23, 2026.
