1. Review Hebrews 8:1-9:22. What have you learned through your study of these chapters? Identify 2 or 3 things you learned about the new covenant and the priesthood of Jesus Christ, and how that has encouraged you.
2. How does Hebrews 9:23 connect back to verses 21-22?
3. In verses 23-24, what is the contrast between the earthly tabernacle and the heavenly tabernacle?
4. What does Jesus' location in the presence of God indicate? (v. 24)
5. According to Hebrews 9:25-26, how is Jesus' sacrifice superior to the sacrifices of the high priests?
6. In verses 27-28, what has Jesus done and what will He do? From Matthew 16:24-26; Acts 1:9-11; 2nd Timothy 4:8; and 1 John 3:2, identify some future realities that await believers.
7. From Hebrews 10:1, what did the law anticipate, and what could it never accomplish?
8. How is the reality that the law was a shadow of the good things to come an argument against returning to Judaism?
9. In Hebrews 10:2-3, what did the sacrifices made under the old covenant not do and what did they make evident to the people?
10. As the preacher continues his defense of Christ's sacrifice, what could the blood of animals never do, according to v.4?

11. In contrast to the blood of animals, what does the blood (death) of Jesus accomplish? Find 3 other references elsewhere in Scripture to support your answer.
