Today is Father's Day. A day that we celebrate our dad's, granddads and other men of influence in our lives. If we are men, it should also be a day that reminds us to pray that God will use us to be men of influence. Father's Day began in 1908 at a church in West Virginia when they gathered to honor dads and also to mourn that many of the men of the community had been killed in a mine explosion the previous December.

In 1910 a lady named Sonora Dodd was moved by a Mother's Day sermon and she began to push to have father's honored as well. She campaigned at the YMCA and local churches to have the holiday officially celebrated. 14 years later the President supported the idea and 42 years after that there was a Presidential proclamation establishing the celebration of Father's Day. However, it took another 6 years for Father's Day to be recognized as a national holiday. It would seem politicians move slowly. The lady who wanted father's honored however didn't move slowly as she campaigned extensively to have this day recognized. She certainly shows us the power of dedication.

Her act of selflessness made me realize that on this Father's Day we should have that same type of dedication to honor our Heavenly Father. She was motivated to make sure that her father was honored. He was a Civil War veteran who had raised 6 children alone. He had made many sacrifices for his family and for his country and she wanted him to be honored because of the blessing he had been to his family and community. Our heavenly Father has been a blessing to us in amazing ways. Some of which we are aware of and some we probably don't even know about. He has provided for us, He has loved us, He has blessed our lives with people, He has taken care of us, and in John 14 the Bible says, "He has prepared a place for us." On top of that He has promised to never leave us or forsake us. He is always with us and has blessed us with a church where we can come and gather with the people of God. Our heavenly Father has been good to us, and He deserves to be honored. In fact, He deserves all the honor, all of glory and all of the praise.

Of course, He has not only blessed us, He has sacrificed. In fact, He gave His one and only Son so that we might not perish but so that we might have the gift of eternal life. Jesus went to the cross willingly and took our place. He willingly took our sins and after taking the punishment that should have been ours, He gave us His righteousness. Because of that He deserves to be celebrated, not just on Father's Day but each and everyday. Everyday is the day that the Lord has made, so let us truly rejoice and be glad in Him! Let us display that same type of dedication that Sonora Dodd displayed to honor her earthly Father. Let us be dedicated to honor Him, to worship Him, and to selflessly make His name known. Who knows how God will work and move as we do those things as people, as families and as a church for His glory!
