CAN GOD BE TRUSTED?

Temptation is often about our desire to meet a legitimate need.

Matthew 4:3

³ The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."

Many temptations aren't about bad desires.

They're about good desires that are pursued in the wrong way.

The temptation is not always the desire. The temptation is the shortcut.

Can God really be trusted?

Temptation is not mainly about self-control. It is about confidence in God.

Matthew 4:4

⁴ Jesus answered, "It is written, 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

Jesus remembers Israel's story.

God fed them physically, but He was teaching them spiritually.

Deuteronomy 8:3-4

³ He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.

⁴ Your clothes did not wear out and your feet did not swell during these forty years.

God wanted them to be dependent on Him for their daily bread.

Self-sufficiency kills trust. And trust is at the heart of your faith.

**One of the greatest weapons against temptation
is remembering the faithfulness of God.**

Where are you most tempted right now to meet a legitimate need in an improper way?

God often meets us in the waiting... in the gap between desire and fulfillment.

Matthew 7:25,32b-34a

²⁵ "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes?"

³² "...your heavenly Father knows that you need these things. ³³ But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. ³⁴ Therefore do not worry about tomorrow..."
