SECOND MILE GIVING FOR JULY– Blessings in a Backpack

Serving Andrews, Flint Springs, Horace Mann, Huntington Catholic, Lincoln, and Salamonie schools, more than 375 students in Huntington County are receiving free lunches at school and are provided a bag of food for nourishment over the weekend from Blessings in a Backpack. This amount is only about 35% of those needed in the county.

Each bag contains breakfast, lunch, dinner, and a snack for Saturday and Sunday. These meals and snacks cost approximately \$3.50 a bag, or \$125 per year for each child. How can you help? 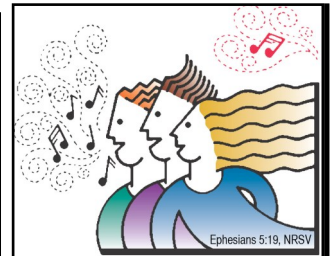

Directions for Singing

From John Wesley's *Select Hymns*, 1761

I. Learn these tunes before you learn any others; afterwards learn as many as you please.

II. Sing them exactly as they are printed here, without altering or mending them at all; and if you have learned to sing them otherwise, unlearn it as soon as you can.

III. Sing all. See that you join with the congregation as frequently as you can. Let not a slight degree of weakness or weariness hinder you. If it is a cross to you, take it up, and you will find it a blessing.

IV. Sing lustily and with a good courage. Beware of singing as if you were half dead, or half asleep; but lift up your voice with strength. Be no more afraid of your voice now, nor more ashamed of its being heard, than when you sung the songs of Satan.

The Retreat Center is ready for summer rentals. It has been a busy and costly 2026.

The year started with a new roof. One of the water heaters quit working. Both heaters were the same age, so both were replaced. A remote control was added to shut down hot water when there is no one in the building for a long period of time.

All bunk beds and mattresses on the lower and main level have been replaced. The new ones have metal frames with side rails and foam mattresses. The loft still has both old and new beds.

Two heavy sweepers were replaced with lighter and easier to handle Shark brand sweepers.

We had some workdays where beds were built and old mattresses were torn apart. We also worked on landscaping. New plants were added and mulch refreshed.

We've had great work crews from the congregation and Harmony Home men. We really appreciate the help the guys have given us.

2028 will be the 100th anniversary of the retreat property. Also, the present building was dedicated 30 years ago. Be thinking of ways we can celebrate this milestone of the church.

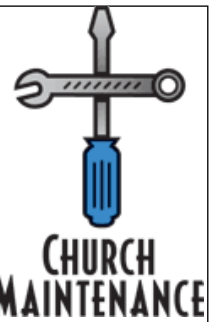
