

**Mosaic Covenant**  
***Standing at the Edge***

**Exodus 34:1-10 NIV**

Then Moses climbed Mount Nebo from the plains of Moab to the top of Pisgah, across from Jericho. There the LORD showed him the whole land—from Gilead to Dan, <sup>2</sup>all of Naphtali, the territory of Ephraim and Manasseh, all the land of Judah as far as the Mediterranean Sea, <sup>3</sup>the Negev and the whole region from the Valley of Jericho, the City of Palms, as far as Zoar. <sup>4</sup>Then the LORD said to him, “This is the land I promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob when I said, ‘I will give it to your descendants.’ I have let you see it with your eyes, but you will not cross over into it.” <sup>5</sup>And Moses the servant of the LORD died there in Moab, as the LORD had said. <sup>6</sup>He buried him in Moab, in the valley opposite Beth Peor, but to this day no one knows where his grave is. <sup>7</sup>Moses was a hundred and twenty years old when he died, yet his eyes were not weak nor his strength gone. <sup>8</sup>The Israelites grieved for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days, until the time of weeping and mourning was over. <sup>9</sup>Now Joshua son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom because Moses had laid his hands on him. So the Israelites listened to him and did what the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>10</sup>Since then, no prophet has risen in Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face,

7. What would happen if God had allowed Moses, the image of the Law, to enter the promised land?
8. What happened to Moses after he witnessed the land? (vs. 5-7)
9. What does this tell you about God's sovereign will and purposes?
10. What is special about where God buried Moses?
11. Read Deuteronomy 31:23. Who did God commission to lead Israel in this next phase?
12. How did Israel respond? (v.9)
13. What honor is recorded about Moses? (v.10)
14. What is the limit of the Law? Read Romans 3:20. Romans 8:7-8, Acts 13:39.
15. If we rely on the Law what is our outcome? Galatians 3:10-11.
16. Read Galatians 3:24-25. What was the point of the Law?
17. How is Moses standing at the edge representative of our faith today? Where are we standing at the edge?
18. What is the significance of having someone else lead Israel into the promised land? Who does Joshua represent?
19. What name is the same as Joshua in Hebrew? What does it mean?
20. Who was Joshua foreshadowing? Read Romans 8:3-4.
21. Read Hebrews 3:5-6. What is the difference between Moses' faithfulness and Jesus' faithfulness? What is the significance?
22. Read Matthew 17:1-3. What happened? Who was there? Where were they in that moment? What does this mean for Moses?
23. Read Ephesians 1:7. How are we redeemed? For what purpose?
24. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. What is past the edge for us to enter?

**Point to ponder:** Faith requires movement. Let us take hold of what God has given us through Christ Jesus.
