<p><b>Chromebook</b> (or Laptop Required for Grades 8-12)                      The school recommends choosing a Chromebook model that will serve your student well throughout high school.</p> <p>Look for the following minimum specifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 8 GB of RAM (recommended for better multitasking and performance)</li> <li>• 64 GB or more of storage</li> <li>• A recent processor (such as an Intel N-series or newer, or equivalent)</li> <li>• A battery life of at least 10 hours</li> <li>• Automatic ChromeOS updates supported for several more years</li> </ul> <p>While 4 GB RAM Chromebooks can handle basic tasks, 8 GB RAM is strongly recommended to ensure smoother performance when working with multiple tabs, Google Workspace apps, and other web-based learning tools.
