We got a lot of quality time with our new leaders, and they became much closer to one another. **Please pray for Jacob, Charlie, AJ, Brielle, Kylie, and Katie to continue building their roots in Christ throughout the summer, and that God will use them to make disciples of Jesus at UNO this year!**
