June Series: Live What Was Built

Week Focus: Reflecting Christ Daily

Scripture – 2 Corinthians 3:18 - *"And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit."*

Devotional Reflection

As we conclude this week, take a moment to reflect on the incredible truth that God is continually transforming His people into the image of Christ. Spiritual growth is not merely about gaining knowledge, attending church services, or developing religious habits. At its core, spiritual growth is about becoming more like Jesus. According to 2 Corinthians 3:18, this transformation is an ongoing work of the Holy Spirit. Day by day, God is shaping our hearts, renewing our minds, and forming Christ's character within us.

Throughout this week, we have been reminded that what we focus on shapes us. As we fix our eyes on Jesus, we begin to think differently, respond differently, and live differently. The more we spend time in His presence, the more His character becomes visible in our lives. Transformation is not accomplished through human effort alone; it happens as we continually surrender ourselves to God and allow His Spirit to work within us.

We also learned that reflecting Christ is not limited to special spiritual moments. It happens in everyday conversations, ordinary responsibilities, and routine interactions. Christ is reflected when we extend grace instead of holding grudges. He is reflected when we choose humility instead of pride, patience instead of frustration, and kindness instead of indifference. The everyday moments of life often become the greatest opportunities to reveal His presence.

Perhaps this week revealed areas where God is already producing growth in your life. Maybe you have become more patient than you once were. Perhaps you are learning to forgive more quickly, love more deeply, or trust God more consistently. Celebrate those signs of growth. They are evidence that the Holy Spirit is at work within you. At the same time, recognize that transformation is not yet complete. God is still working, still refining, and still shaping you into the person He has called you to become.

As you prepare for a new week, carry this truth with you: God is not finished with you. The same Spirit who began this work will continue it. Keep your eyes on Jesus. Remain surrendered to His leading. Continue reflecting His character in your daily life. The more closely you walk with Christ, the more clearly others will see Him in you. And that is the ultimate goal of transformation—not that people would notice us, but that they would see Jesus through us.

Focus for Today

The more I walk with Christ, the more my life reflects His character.

 - In what area have I become more like Christ over the past year?
 - Where is God currently shaping my character?
 - How have I reflected God's grace to others this week?

Help me remain focused on Jesus and surrendered to Your leading. Continue developing Your character within me so that my life reflects Your love, grace, humility, and truth.
