Jesus Helps a Non-Jewish Woman

John 5:2-6 NCV

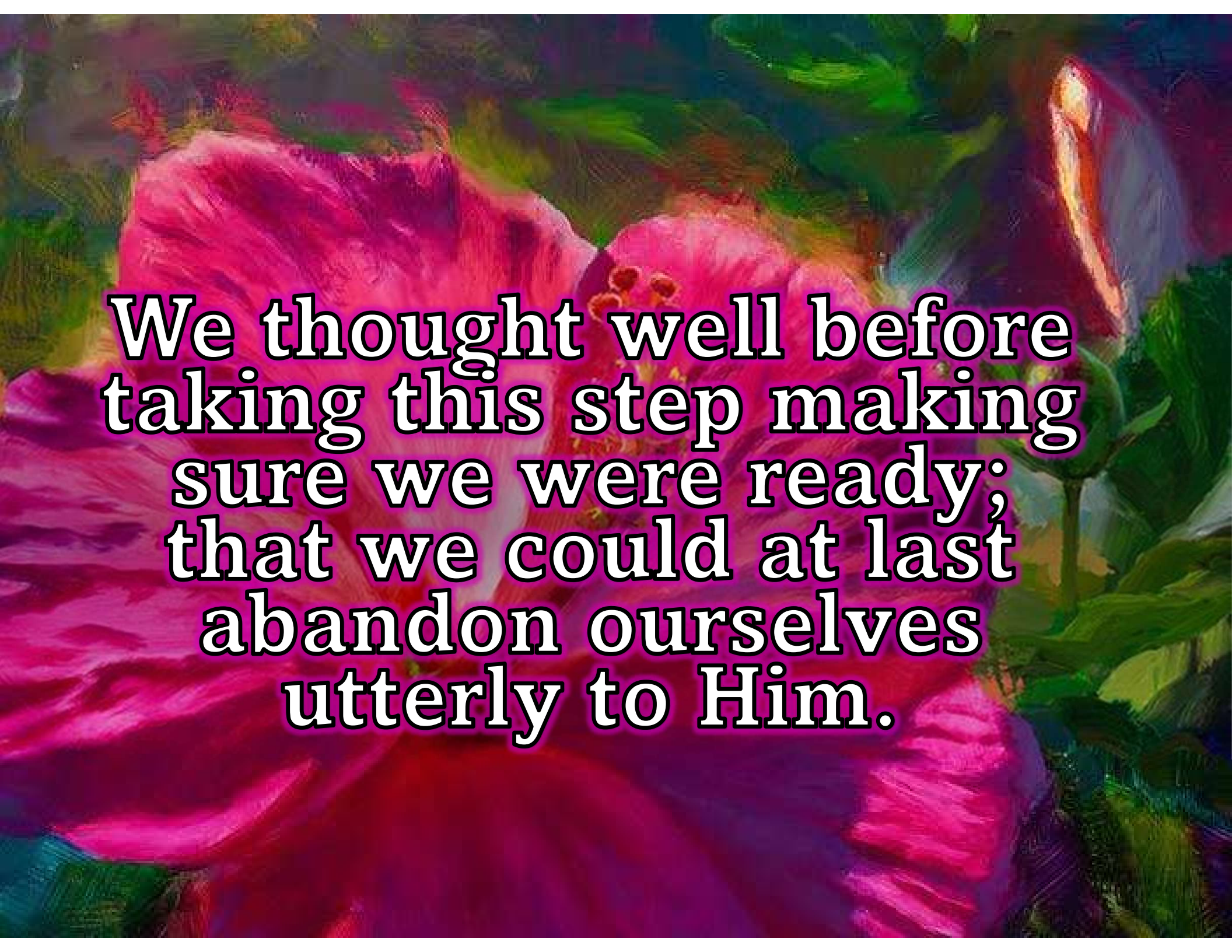
