Passage: 1 Corinthians 11:2-16

1 Tim 2:9 “Likewise, I want women to adorn themselves with proper clothing, modestly and discreetly, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments”

Men, as most of us know, are sight oriented; and so, when a woman dresses indiscreetly, this can become a m_____ d_____ for some.

Deut 22:5 “A woman shall not wear man's clothing, nor shall a man put on a woman's clothing; for whoever does these things is an abomination to the LORD your God.”

I. Some Principles of A_____ Have Been R_____

1) We Have a Doctrinal C_____

Acts 18:11 “And he (Paul) settled there a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them.”

Paul spent eighteen months in Corinth, and we can be sure that one of the things he did during this time was that he helped them to become g_____ doctrinally.

2) We Have a Doctrinal C_____

Phil 2:6-7 “6...although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.”

The point Paul is making is that God did not create the man and the woman at the same time, and He created the woman F_____ the man and F_____ the man.

1 Tim 2:12 “But I do not allow a woman to teach or exercise authority over a man, ...”

Jesus, who is God the Son is equal to God the Father; but nevertheless, He chose of His own volition to s_____ to the will of God the Father.
