1. \_\_\_\_\_. From the Greek word **Pistis** (πίστις) which can mean: Faith, trust, faithfulness, or reliability

2. \_\_\_\_\_. From the Greek word **Prautēs** (πραΰτης) which means meekness. Strength under control.

3. \_\_\_\_\_. From the Greek word **Egkrateia** (ἐγκράτεια) which means mastery over desires and impulses.

- **Self-control is the Spirit directing the direction of growth.**
