**Big Idea:** When Isaiah encountered the presence of God, his first response was not to ask for details, guarantees, or benefits. He simply said, “Here I am; send me.” True availability begins with a surrendered heart, not with knowing the plan.

## Availability Begins With An \_\_\_\_\_

- **Read:** Isaiah 6:1–4
- Isaiah’s availability did not appear out of nowhere. It was born out of a moment with God.
- Before he ever heard God’s voice, he saw God’s glory.
- And when Isaiah sees God clearly, everything else gets put in its proper place.
- Availability begins when we stop asking God to fit into our plans and start asking how our lives can fit into His purposes.
- When you truly see God for who He is, your yes becomes less about what He is asking and more about who is asking.

- The closer Isaiah gets to the presence of God, the more aware he becomes of his own sinfulness.
- And in the light of God’s holiness, he realizes how deeply he needs mercy.
- Before God sends Isaiah, He cleanses Isaiah.
