

CEMETERY BY-LAWS
HOLY TRINITY CEMETERY
MADAWASKA, ONTARIO

Holy Trininty Cemetery is governed by the Statutes of Ontario as prescribed by the Cemetery Act, 1992. Holy Trinity's Cemetery operates under the section of the Cemetery Act, 1992. The following By-Laws are set for the operation of Holy Trinity Cemetery:

1. INTERMENT RIGHTS: which also include Care and Maintenance, shall be sold at a rate set forth in the tariff of rates, which is filed and approved by the Registrar and is as follows:

<u>Parishioner Rates:</u>	\$200.00
(included in above rate is 150.00 for the Care and Maintenance deposited with Incorporated Synod in Ottawa.	
<u>Non-Parishioner Rate:</u>	\$500.00
(included in above rate is 200.00 for the Care and Maintenance deposited with Incorporated Synod in Ottawa.	
- Notice of each interment to be made shall be given at least 48 hours previous, to Pastor or member of Cemetery Committee, except in special circumstances.
- Requirements for interment to take place are:
 1. burial permit
 2. undertaker
 3. interment rights certificate (including Care & Maintenance Fee & Monument Care Fee)
 4. Ashes (presence of Funeral Director and /or a member of Cemetery Committee)
2. No interment shall be made on Sunday except on a doctor's certificate that the burial must be made within 24 hours of death in accordance with the regulations of the Ontario Ministry of Health for the control of communicable diseases.
- No interments shall take place from November to April or as weather permits in the Spring.
3. No disinterment will take place without the written consent of the Cemetery Committee, the local medical officer of health and the Rights Owner, if living, except on an order from the Court or as provided in the Regulations under the Cemeteries Act.

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4. If any existing trees or shrubs by means of their roots, branches or any other part, have a detrimental effect to burial sites, or monuments, or appearance of the grounds, the Cemetery Committee may have such trees or shrubs, or parts removed.
5. The erection of borders, fences, railings, walls, hedges, and non-commercial markers in or around the burial sites is prohibited. No shrubs, trees, flowers, etc. are permitted, other than flowers in transportable pot.
6. No person(s) shall do any work on any interment site without the permission of the Cemetery Committee.
7. MONUMENTS: only flat or markers 4 feet or under, will be allowed from henceforth to be installed in Holy Trinity Cemetery.
8. Children are not permitted on the cemetery grounds unless the they are being cared for by an adult who shall assume responsibility for their safety.
9. Former parishioners of the Holy Trinity of Madawaska may be interred providing they or their spouse were at one time a parishioner of the Holy Trinity of Madawaska. Interment Rights for former parishioner may only be sold at the time of their death.
10. Only Service and Maintenance vehicles are allowed in the Cemeteries.
11. Interment rights purchased by an individual may only be sold back to the Holy Trinity of Madawaska.
12. No person may purchase interment rights to more than two lots, except in special circumstances.
13. No more than 4?? urns of ashes may be interred in any one lots.
14. Grave digging is only to be dug by funeral Director Employees, no wooden rough boxes are to be used.
