



Quiet Time Questions from May 10, 2026

Main Point of the Sermon: The Lord is with His people in all circumstances—the Lord is with us.

Verses for Memory and Meditation: *“Slaves, obey your human masters in everything. Don’t work only while being watched, as people-pleasers, but work wholeheartedly, fearing the Lord. Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people...”* (Colossians 3:22–23)

1. **Read Genesis 39.** Are you able to say today—***The Lord is with me.*** Even when you cannot see the whole picture or have all the answers? Are you fully surrendered to where the Lord has you and to what He may be doing?
2. **Read Genesis 39.** Are you able to say today—no matter the circumstances, even when sin seems advantageous—I will not sin against the Lord, but will flee temptation? Do you see, as Joseph did, that your sin would be against God?
3. **Read Genesis 39.** Are you able to say today—no matter the circumstances, even in the darkest valley or deepest prison—I will trust the Lord?
