Main Point of the Sermon: Even in the midst of unfair suffering, God is still with us, working through our pain, and never forgetting His people.

Verses for Memory and Meditation: *"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." (Romans 8:28)*

1. Read once again Genesis 41 and answer the following question.

Why do you think Joseph was able to trust God after thirteen years of slavery and imprisonment? What can we learn from his example?

2. Prepare for your SMALLL Groups by reading again Genesis 41. Answer the following question.

When have you seen God's timing make sense only after looking back on a difficult season?

3. Reflect on Genesis 41. Memorize Romans 8:28. Then, answer the following question.

Joseph said God made him "fruitful in the land of my suffering." What spiritual fruit can God produce through hardship that might not grow during easier seasons of life?
