



Quiet Time Questions from April 12, 2026

Main Point of the Sermon: God's choices work out His purposes. Yet our choices, especially whether we respond to His Spirit in faith and obedience, have real and lasting consequences.

Verse for Memorization and Meditation: *"But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."* (Joshua 24:15)

1. **Read Genesis 36:1-9.** How do you see both God's sovereignty and Esau's personal choices shaping the outcome of his life and legacy? Where do you see God's hand at work? Where do you see the consequences of Esau's decisions?
2. **Read Genesis 36.** What are some areas in your life today where your choices have significant spiritual impact (like marriage, obedience, or compromise)? How can you discern whether you are responding to God's leading or acting on your own desires?
3. **Read Joshua 24:15.** God's Spirit convicts and leads us, yet we are still called to respond. What does it look like to faithfully respond to God's prompting in your daily life? How can you avoid resisting or ignoring His leading? What practical steps help you live out that response consistently?
