



Quiet Time Questions from May 17, 2026

Main Point of the Sermon: Even in the midst of unfair suffering, God is still with us, working through our pain, and never forgetting His people.

Verses for Memory and Meditation: *“But while Joseph was there in the prison, the Lord was with him; he showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden.”* (Genesis 39:20-21)

1. **Read Genesis 39:19-23 and Genesis 40.** Joseph continued to serve others and honor God even while suffering unjustly. What does Joseph’s response to pain teach us about faithfulness during difficult seasons of life?
2. **Read Genesis 39:19-23 and Genesis 40.** Joseph noticed the sadness of the cupbearer and baker even while he himself was hurting. Why is it often difficult to see the needs of others when we are in pain, and how can believers remain spiritually attentive during suffering?
3. **Read Genesis 39:19-23 and Genesis 40.** The cupbearer forgot Joseph, but God did not forget him. How do Isaiah 49:15 and Joseph’s story encourage believers who feel abandoned, overlooked, or forgotten today?
