



### Quiet Time Questions from June 07, 2026

**Main Point of the Sermon:** Because God faithfully provides for His people, we can repent of our sin, trust His promises, and live by faith rather than fear.

**Verses for Memory and Meditation:** *"Their hearts sank and they turned to each other trembling and said, 'What is this that God has done to us?'"* (Genesis 42:28b)

**1. Read Genesis 42:1-2 and Philippians 4:19.**

What situation in my life is causing me to focus on my problems rather than God's provision and promises? Ask God to help you see His provision and direction instead of becoming paralyzed by fear, worry, or uncertainty.

**2. Read Genesis 42:21-23 and Psalm 139:23-24.**

Is there any sin, hurt, or area of disobedience that I am still trying to hide from God or others? Invite the Lord to search your heart and reveal anything that needs to be confessed, surrendered, or made right.

**3. Read Genesis 42:9 along with one of the promises cited in the sermon (John 16:33, John 14:18-19, Romans 8:38-39, or Revelation 21:4).**

What promise of God do I need to remember and trust today instead of giving in to fear? Write down the promise that speaks most directly to your current circumstances and pray it back to God.
