and their encounter with the Creator in this place goes before our own.

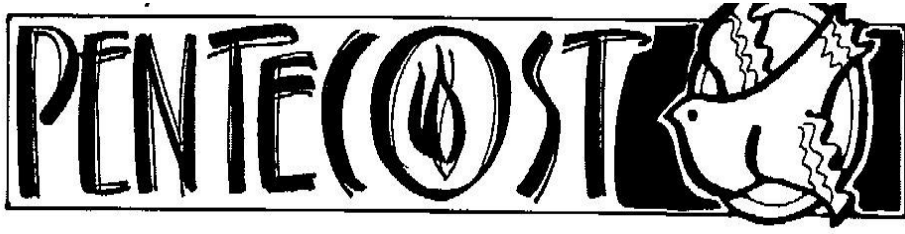

- *Celestial Queer, the Life, Work and Wonder of James MacSwain*

Thursday, July 2nd | 7:00 to 9pm | Salt Spring Public Library

Join us for a film that documents the life and work of James MacSwain,
a queer artist whose work brings together humour, politics, beauty,
imagination, and queer visibility. Equal parts art project, history lesson,
and whimsy, this film offers a portrait of an artist who defied conven-
tion for a life lived on his own terms.

Directors Eryn Foster & Sue Johnson spent a decade checking in with
the witty, erudite MacSwain as he moved about his life in north end
Halifax, returned to his tiny rural hometown of Amherst, Nova Scotia
— where he grew up, unable to pass for straight, in the 1950s — and
discussed his wildly inventive art practice. The playful work is cut out,
glued together, and sung into intricate collages, analogue films combin-
ing handmade animation with documentary & provocative exhibitions.
Johnson & Foster, who knew MacSwain for decades until his death in
2025, combine myriad formats in production (including 16mm, Super-
8, and digital video) for an intimate patchwork celebration reflective of
their subject's own body of work. *Celestial Queer* now stands as an
elegy for a man who was defiantly original, internationally renowned,
and an icon of artistic integrity. James MacSwain lived how he wanted
— unabashed, uncompromising, and unforgettable.

After the film, stay for a Q&A with the filmmaker and a conversation
about queer art, belonging, creativity, and the role of community in
keeping queer stories visible.
