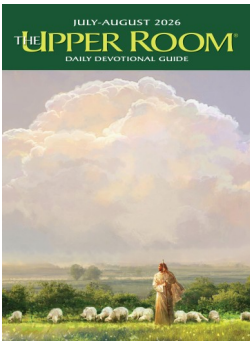

Back-to-School Supplies **ALL Back-to-School Supplies must be** **received by Sunday, July 26**

We've had great response to the Back-to-School Supplies for our Kindergarten through 5th grade students. But there are still items we need to fill their Back-packs with everything on the school supply lists. Paper crayons with items needed are on the table in the Narthex. Stop by, and see what you can do to help fill their backpacks.

Some of the school supplies are shared by the children in the classroom: We still need pump bottles of hand sanitizer, refillable water bottles, and Ziplock bags in different sizes.

The hand sanitizers help to keep little hands clean and the water bottles can be refilled at the water fountains, so little mouths are not on the fountain spout. These are just small efforts to help our young students stay healthy during the school year. Most of the classroom teachers try to keep the classroom stocked with facial tissue, hand sanitizer and wet wipes to keep the students healthy.

Paper crayons will be available today and through July 19. We ask you to sign out on a 3" x 5" card with your name and the Crayon numbers you take.

Go to your favorite store, and shop for the items on the Crayons. Please put the "Paper Crayons" in the bag with the items you've purchased.

We will also accept cash gifts, or checks made out to Roselle UWF (Roselle United Women in Faith) to buy some of the more expensive items, and/or items that must be ordered online ie, headphones for each student, lunch bags, and other things. Donations of cash or items to the UWF are fully deductible on your income tax.

Helping Our Students Have a Healthy School Year

Most of the classroom teachers try to keep the classroom stocked with these items to keep the students healthy. Kindergarten to 5th Grade students are usually very susceptible to colds.
