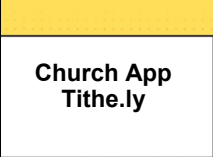

SUNDAY SCHOOL SPOTLIGHT



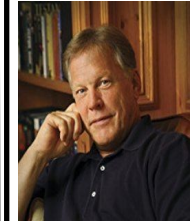
