WHEN HELP ARRIVES

What if they hadn't shown up? Have you ever had one of those moments when you thought, "If they hadn't arrived when they did, I don't know what would have happened?"

Hollywood examples of heroes arriving "just in the nick of time."

Psalm 124:1a

^{1a} "If the Lord had not been on our side—"

What if God had not intervened?

Consider what life would be like without God's presence.

Psalm 124 is one of the Psalms of Ascent, songs sung by Jewish pilgrims as they traveled uphill to Jerusalem, and likely to God's Temple. It was in preparation as they drew near to God, much like our Christmas songs today that celebrate what God has done.

Psalm 124:1b

^{1b} "If the Lord had not been on our side—let Israel say—"

Remember what God has brought us through. Say it collectively.

Declare it for all to hear. Because people tend to forget.

Imagine life without God's intervention.

Psalm 124:2-5

² "if the Lord had not been on our side when people attacked us, ³ they would have swallowed us alive when their anger flared against us; ⁴ the flood would have engulfed us, the torrent would have swept over us, ⁵ the raging waters would have swept us away."

**Take time to remember the moments when God carried, protected,
provided, forgave, and sustained you.**

Praise God for every deliverance.

Psalm 124:6-7

"Praise be to the Lord, who has not let us be torn by their teeth. We have escaped like a bird from the fowler's snare; the snare has been broken, and we have escaped."

**Remembering God's faithfulness leads to worship;
not because life is perfect, but because He has always been faithful.**

God's presence is greater than every problem.

Psalm 124:8

⁸ "Our help is in the name of the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth."

Share Your Testimony:

- Israel passed God's stories from one generation to the next because future generations need to know what God has done.
- Our testimony becomes someone else's encouragement.
- Never underestimate how God can use your story to strengthen another person's faith.

The Gospel Connection: Psalm 124 ultimately points to Jesus Christ:

- Humanity could not rescue itself from sin.
- At just the right time, God intervened through Jesus.
- Christ's death and resurrection provide the greatest rescue in history.
- Our deepest need is not simply protection from life's troubles but salvation through Christ.

**Look back as you look ahead. Knowing where you're going, remember where you've been.
Israel's journey to Jerusalem and the Temple resembles our journey to Heaven.**
