### **“Holy Affections”**

**1 John 3:19-24**

**A new view of salvation that has come on the scene, is categorized by having a permanent nature of regeneration and a \_\_\_\_\_ nature of experiencing that regeneration.**

**The pursuit of holiness is the proof of salvation.**

**Today, people don't know the gospel well enough to be frightened that they might not be really saved.**

**The first component of religious affection is love for other Christians.**

**This is a chief sign in zeal for holiness, a love toward the brethren, is the chief manifestation of the regenerating work of God.**

**This is a love in \_\_\_\_\_ and in \_\_\_\_\_.**

**This is a noble love, which is not shallow, not superficial, not selective. It is a kind of abandoned love in the sense that it yields up everything, even, if necessary, life itself, for the benefit of those who are in Christ.**

**It is the mark of true salvation.**

**If you know someone who says they believe in Jesus, most importantly, determine the validity of that claim by how sacrificial, involved, passionate, and affectionate they are toward other believers.**

**And if they do not \_\_\_\_\_ a \_\_\_\_\_, you have every right to question the validity of their salvation.**
