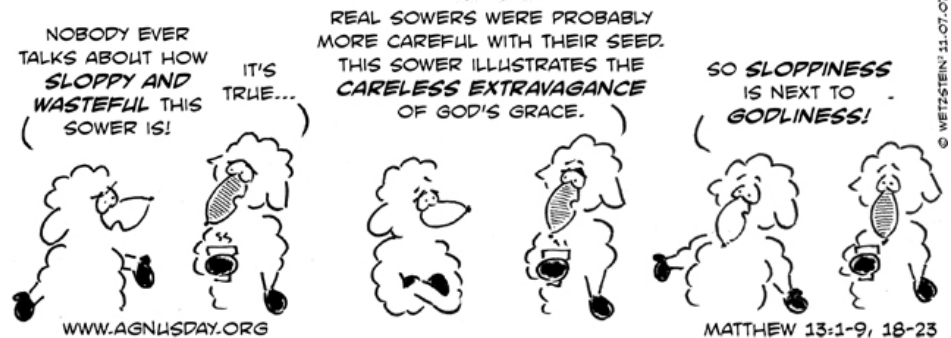


Today's lessons:

- Genesis 25:19-34 Isaac and Rebekah become the parents of twins, two boys completely unlike. From birth Jacob, the younger, tries to get the better of his brother Esau. Being the smart one, Jacob finally gets Esau to selling him his birthright for a simple dinner.
- Psalms 119:105-112 Psalm 119 has one section for every letter in the Hebrew alphabet. In each section every verse begins with the same Hebrew letter. In all of them God's word is praised.
- Romans 8:1-11 Because we are – through our Baptism – in Christ, we don't have to follow those impulses that go against God's will.
- Matthew 13:1-9,18-23 Jesus compares the way his message is received to what happens with the seed that is sown: depending on the ground it falls on, it may come to nothing — or it may bring rich harvest.
