Amanda Elementary children and parents appreciate your Christian love and academic encouragement.

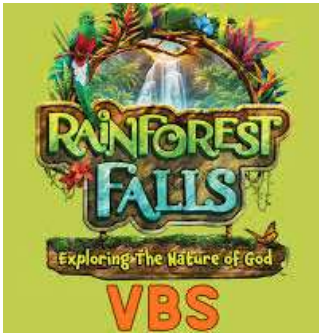
