This past week we faced problems with the “immigrant worker crisis” especially in the Strand location where Simanyene Center is located. Safety was a big issue. Thankfully, it is ending peacefully.

Thank you for praying for our Holiday Bible Times in the 3 churches. Mfuleni started their Holiday Bible Time literally in the dark with no electricity. Skollies (thieves) cut the powerlines for the copper, so there was no electric for the visuals or lights in the church. This was the day they began and continued to have problems all through the week. Nevertheless, they averaged 55 children through the week and 9 children trusted in Jesus as their Savior. Praise the Lord!

Happy Valley had a small group this year. Many were little children but we also saw fruit from this Holiday Bible Time as well. The team functioned so well together that I wondered why I was there! The kids enjoyed the lessons, songs, mission story, and games. Our goal is to build up our Sunday School program.

Stellenbosch was very well attended and averaged 55 children throughout the week. Many Junior High kids were there, and a group of 6 teen boys came. We’re praying they would start to come to Sunday School. We had several young people and children saved in each location. We praise the Lord for this new fruit, which means we have a lot of work to do—teaching and training.
