Treasury Notes

We finished June with total monthly donations of \$22,035, About \$8,000 below the goal of \$30,000. Throughout June weekly donations continued on a downward trend, and regrettably this trend has continued into July. Our July Sunday goals are \$3,600 plus PAG of \$13,600 for a monthly target of \$28,000. In week one, Sunday donations were \$1,470. Traditionally, we see a drop off of donations during the summer months when people are away on holiday; however, the current trend is worrying.
