Big Idea: A strong life of faith is one that keeps growing.

Second Peter is one of the final letters the Apostle Peter wrote before his death. And Peter reminds us that the Christian life is not just about starting well.

God Has Given Us Everything We _____

- **Read:** 2 Peter 1:3–4
- Before Peter tells believers what to do, he reminds them of what God has already done. Then Peter says God’s divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness.
- Sometimes we talk ourselves out of spiritual growth because we think we are missing something. But Peter says God has already given us everything we need through our knowledge of Him.

We Have To _____

- **Read:** 2 Peter 1:5–7
- Peter says, “For this very reason, make every effort...”
- Spiritual maturity does not happen by accident. Growth requires intention. He says to add to your faith: Goodness, Knowledge, Self-control, Perseverance, Godliness, Mutual affection, and Love
- So here is the question for us today: Where is God calling you to grow?

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- Philippians 2 says to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, because it is God who works in you.
- First Timothy 4 says to train yourself to be godly.
- We have to build.

Growth Leads To Fruitfulness And _____

- **Read:** 2 Peter 1:8–11
- Peter says if these qualities are increasing in us, they will keep us from being ineffective and unproductive in our knowledge of Jesus.
- Peter is saying, “If you want your life to be fruitful, keep growing in Christ.” Then Peter says, “If you do these things, you will never stumble.”
- It means a growing faith becomes a steady faith.
