Personal Reflection Questions

1. Is there a place, situation, or relationship in which you have become newly aware of God's presence this week?
2. What does it mean for you to approach God with both confidence and reverence?
3. How is God inviting you to reflect His character more fully in your daily life?
4. How does the cross help you take both God's holiness and His grace seriously?
5. As you hear God say, "Remove your sandals," what response is He inviting from you today?

Group Reflection Questions

1. What stood out to you most from Moses' encounter at the burning bush?
2. What does this passage teach us about holding together God's holiness and His nearness?
3. The sermon suggested that the tension isn't between God's holiness and His love, but between God's holiness and our sinfulness. How does that shape your understanding of the gospel?
4. What does it mean to take God's holiness seriously without becoming afraid of Him?
5. What might it look like for our church to live more wide-eyed to both God's presence and His holiness?
