

**The Sacrifice that Provides Forgiveness and the Believer's
Confidence and the Believer's Way
Hebrews 10:15-25 (August 9, 2026)**

1. The new covenant was ushered in by Jesus' death on the cross to atone for the sins of man. Which of its features are highlighted in Hebrews 10:16-17, which quotes from Jeremiah 31:33-34?
2. Briefly describe the new covenant.
3. In Hebrews 10:18, what point is reiterated about the cessation of the sacrifices made under the old covenant?
4. Review Hebrews 9:23-10:18 and note which Old Testament Scriptures are quoted by the author. What does that reveal about God's word?
5. From your study of Hebrews 10:1-18, list 2 or 3 main points and how they encouraged or convicted you.
6. Read Hebrews 10:19-25 and write down 4 to 5 observations or key words and phrases.
7. From verse 19, what word does the preacher use to refer to his audience, and what pronouns does he use throughout this passage? What does this reveal about his relationship to them, and how does it impact the tone of his words?
8. In verse 19, what key truth from Hebrews does the word "since" re-introduce? List one or two other passages where you have already seen this theme in Hebrews.

9. From Hebrews 9:11-12 and 23-24, where are the “holy places” to which the author refers in Hebrews 10:19, and on what basis do believers have confidence to enter there?
10. In Hebrews 10:19, what words are used to describe the way that believers enter the holy places, and how is this way open to believers?
11. Based on Hebrews 7:18-19, 23-25, and 8:7-13, in what sense is this a “new” and “living” way?
12. From Hebrews 10:20, describe the connection between the veil of the tabernacle/temple and the body, or physical sacrifice, of Jesus. See Matthew 27:50-51
