People **We will strive to sustain and renew the life of the earth. Amen**

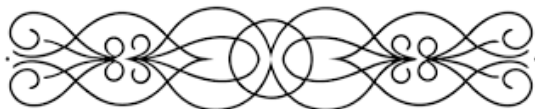
