1-7 - Jesus is better.

8-10 - So the New Covenant is better than the Old.

11-13 - And faith in Jesus is better than the Law.

***Five Warnings:**

1 - Do not drift away (2:1-4).

2 - Do not be hardened by sin (3:7-29).

3 - Do not become sluggish (5:11-6:12).

4 - Do not shrink back (10:26-39).

5 - Do not refuse God (12:14-29).

(Hebrews 3:14 ESV)**

**“So we see that they were unable to enter
because of unbelief.”**

(Hebrews 3:19 ESV)

(See also 1 Corinthians 10:1-6).

Author of Hebrews to both:

**“Do not harden your hearts...hold to the end...
you do not enter because of unbelief.”**

**We have full assurance of our salvation
as we hold fast to our confession
of Christ as Lord.**

Stated differently

**You don't hold fast to Christ to earn your
salvation, you hold fast to Christ because
He is your only hope of salvation.**
