Deuteronomy 29:7-11 AMP

[7] When you reached this place, Sihon the king of Heshbon and Og the king of Bashan came out to meet us in battle, but we defeated them; [8] and we took their land and gave it as an inheritance to the tribe of Reuben, the tribe of Gad, and the half-tribe of Manasseh. [9] So **keep the words** of this covenant and obey them, so that you may prosper and be successful in everything that you do. [10] "All of you stand today before the LORD your God—your chiefs, your tribes, your elders and your officers, even all the men of Israel, [11] your little ones, your wives, and the stranger (resident alien, foreigner) who is in your camps, from the one who chops and gathers your firewood to the one who draws your water—

1 Chronicles 10:11-14 AMP

[11] When all Jabesh-gilead heard about everything that the Philistines had done to Saul, [12] all the brave men arose, took away the body of Saul and the bodies of his sons and brought them to Jabesh, and they buried their bones under the oak in Jabesh; then they fasted seven days. [13] So Saul died for his trespass which he committed against the LORD, for his failure to **keep the word** of the LORD; and also because he consulted a medium [regarding a spirit of the dead], to inquire of her, [14] and did not inquire of the LORD [instead]. Therefore the LORD killed him and turned the kingdom over to David the son of Jesse.

Proverbs 22:15-21 CEB

[15] Folly is bound up in a child's heart; the rod of discipline removes it. [16] Oppressing the poor to get rich and giving to the wealthy lead only to poverty. [17] Turn your ear and hear the words of the wise; focus your mind on my knowledge. [18] It will be pleasant if you **keep the words** in you, if you have them ready on your lips. [19] So that your trust will be in the LORD, I'm teaching you today—yes, you. [20] Haven't I written for you thirty sayings full of advice and knowledge? [21] Their purpose is to teach you true, reliable words, so you can report back reliably to those who sent you.

Revelation 22:7-11 BSB

[7] "Behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of prophecy in this book." [8] And I am John, who heard and saw these things. And when I had heard and seen them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who had shown me these things. [9] But he said to me, "Do not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who **keep the words** of this book. Worship God!" [10] Then he told me, "Do not seal up the words of prophecy in this

book, because the time is near. [11] Let the unrighteous continue to be unrighteous, and the vile continue to be vile; let the righteous continue to practice righteousness, and the holy continue to be holy."
