Genesis 31:53 CEB

The God of Abraham and **the God of** Nahor will **keep** order between us.” So Jacob gave his **word** in **the** name **of the** awesome one **of** his father Isaac.

Deuteronomy 4:2 AMP

You shall not add to **the word** which I am commanding you, nor take away from it, so that you may **keep the** commandments **of the** LORD your **God** which I am commanding you.

Deuteronomy 17:19 AMP

And it shall be with him and he shall read it all **the days of** his life, so that he may learn to fear [and worship] **the** LORD his **God** [with awe-filled reverence and profound respect], by carefully obeying (**keeping** foremost in his thoughts and actively doing) all **the words of** this law and **these** statutes,

Deuteronomy 28:58 CEB

If you don't carefully **keep** all **the words of** this Instruction that are written in this scroll, by fearing **the** awesome and glorious name **of the** LORD your **God**—

Deuteronomy 29:29 CEB

The secret things belong to **the** LORD our **God**. **The** revealed things belong to us and to our children forever: to **keep** all **the words of** this covenant.

1 Samuel 26:19 AMP

Now **therefore**, please let my lord **the** king hear **the words of** his servant. If **the** LORD has incited you against me, let Him accept an **offering** [from me]; but if it is men, may **they** be cursed before **the** LORD, because **they** have driven me out this day to **keep** me from sharing in **the** inheritance **of the** LORD, saying, ‘Go, serve other **gods**.’

1 Kings 13:21 CEB

He cried out to **the** man **of God** who had come from Judah: “**The** LORD says this: You rebelled against **the** LORD's **word**! You didn't **keep the** command that **the** LORD your **God** gave you!

2 Kings 5:7 NASB

But when **the** king **of** Israel read **the** letter, he tore his clothes and said, “Am I **God**, to kill and to **keep** alive, that this man is sending **word** to me to cure a man **of** his leprosy? But consider now, and see how he is seeking a quarrel against me.”

2 Chronicles 30:1 BSB

Then Hezekiah sent **word** throughout all Israel and Judah, and he also wrote letters to Ephraim and Manasseh inviting **them** to come to **the** house **of the** LORD in Jerusalem to **keep the** Passover **of the** LORD, **the God of** Israel.

Proverbs 29:16-20 AMP

[16] When **the** wicked are in authority, transgression increases, But **the** righteous will see **the** downfall **of the** wicked. [17] Correct your son, and he will give you comfort; Yes, he will delight your soul. [18] Where **there** is no vision [no revelation **of God** and His **word**], **the** people are unrestrained; But happy and blessed is he who **keeps the** law [**of God**]. [19] A servant will not be corrected by **words** alone; For though he understands, he will not respond [nor pay attention]. [20] Do you see a [conceited] man who speaks quickly [**offering** his opinions or answering without thinking]? **There** is more hope for a [thickheaded] fool than for him.

Jeremiah 17:15 TLB

Men scoff at me and say, "What is this **word of the** Lord you **keep** talking about? If **these** threats **of** yours are really from **God**, why don't **they** come true?"

Jeremiah 44:25 BSB

This is what **the** LORD **of** Hosts, **the God of** Israel, says: As for you and your wives, you have spoken with your mouths and fulfilled with your hands your **words**: 'We will surely perform our vows that we have made to burn incense to **the** Queen **of** Heaven and to pour out drink **offerings** to her.' Go ahead, **then**, do what you have promised! **Keep** your vows!

Luke 11:26-30 HCSB

[26] **Then** it goes and brings seven other spirits more evil than itself, and **they** enter and settle down **there**. As a result, that man's last condition is worse than **the** first." [27] As He was saying **these** things, a woman from **the** crowd raised her voice and said to Him, "**The** womb that bore You and **the** one who nursed You are blessed!" [28] He said, "Even more, those who hear **the word of God** and **keep** it are blessed!" [29] As **the** crowds were increasing, He began saying: "This generation is an evil generation. It demands a sign, but no sign will be given to it except **the** sign **of** Jonah. [30] For just as Jonah became a sign to **the** people **of** Nineveh, so also **the** Son **of** Man will be to this generation.

1 Timothy 6:18-21 AMP

[18] Instruct **them** to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous, willing to share [with others]. [19] In this way storing up for **themselves the** enduring riches **of** a good foundation for **the** future, so that **they** may take hold **of** that which is truly

life. [20] O Timothy, guard and **keep** safe **the** deposit [**of** **godly** truth] entrusted to you, turn away from worldly and **godless** chatter [with its profane, empty **words**], and **the** contradictions **of** what is falsely called “knowledge”— [21] which some have professed and by doing so have erred (missed **the** mark) and strayed from **the** faith. Grace be with you.

Titus 2:3-8 KJV

[3] **The** aged women likewise, that **they** be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers **of** good things; [4] That **they** may teach **the** young women to be sober, to love **their** husbands, to love **their** children, [5] To be discreet, chaste, **keepers** at home, good, obedient to **their** own husbands, that **the word of God** be not blasphemed. [6] Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. [7] In all things shewing thyself a pattern **of** good works: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, [8] Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is **of the** contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say **of** you.

1 John 2:4-7 AMP

[4] Whoever says, “I have come to know Him,” but does not habitually **keep** [focused on His precepts and obey] His commandments (teachings), is a liar, and **the** truth [**of the** divine **word**] is not in him. [5] But whoever habitually **keeps** His **word** and obeys His precepts [and treasures His message in its entirety], in him **the** love **of** **God** has truly been perfected [it is completed and has reached maturity]. By this we know [for certain] that we are in Him: [6] whoever says he lives in Christ [that is, whoever says he has accepted Him as **God** and Savior] ought [as a moral obligation] to walk and conduct himself just as He walked and conducted Himself. [7] Beloved, I am not writing a new commandment to you, but an old commandment which you have had from **the** beginning; **the** old commandment is **the** message which you have heard [before from us].

Revelation 22:7-11 BSB

[7] “Behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is **the** one who **keeps the words of** prophecy in this book.” [8] And I, John, am **the** one who heard and saw **these** things. And when I had heard and seen **them**, I fell down to worship at **the** feet **of the** angel who had shown me **these** things. [9] But he said to me, “Do not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers **the** prophets, and with those who **keep the words of** this book. Worship **God**!” [10] **Then** he told me, “Do not seal up **the words of** prophecy in this book, because **the** time is near. [11] Let **the** unrighteous continue to be unrighteous, and **the** vile continue to be vile; let **the** righteous continue to practice righteousness, and **the** holy continue to be holy.”
