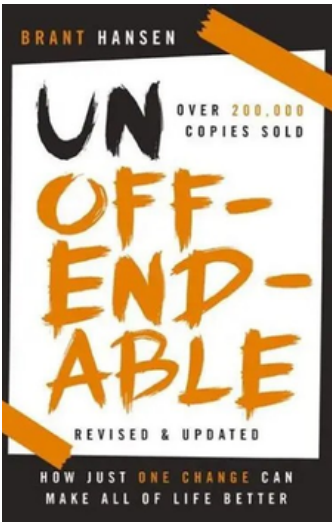
THE MOMCO
