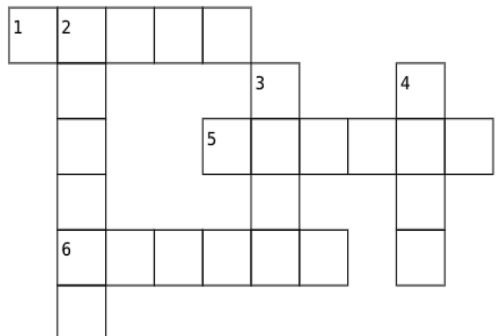

FAMILY DEVOTION

"So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free." - John 8:36

SAY:

Prisons come in all sorts of shapes and sizes. Sometimes they are prisons of circumstances that were forced on us. Other times, they are prisons of our own making.

No matter what kind of prison we find ourselves in, we can rest assured that God is able to set us free!

READ:

Acts 12

DISCUSS:

- Who was in prison?
- Who appeared to Peter in prison?
- Did Peter stay in prison? What happened?
- Were people surprised to see Peter out of jail?

SAY:

Through the story of Peter in prison, we learn that God is able to set us free from any prison we are in. It may seem like God has forgotten us, but He will always come through.

All we must do is call on God and He will provide a way of escape. He may not come in the exact way or time that we want, but God will always come through - right on time!

PRAY:

Pray with your children who might be in a jail of sinful habits. After some time in prayer, celebrate with them that God has set them free! Remind them to obey God from this point forward.
