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- August 16 & 23 are open weeks for you to preview the ministry before committing. These weeks will feature a large group with a testimony, as well as a smaller group to give you a taste of what the 14-week, small-group format will be like.
- August 30 will be the first week of closed small groups, as each couple will be placed and notified by your small group leader by Tuesday, August 25. Lesson 1 should be completed and ready to discuss with your group.
- September 6 re|engage will not meet due to Labor Day Weekend.
- November 29 re|engage will not meet due to Thanksgiving Weekend.
- Celebration Night will be on Sunday, December 13. We will not only celebrate the completion of re|engage, but also what God has done in our marriages through the re|engage ministry.
- Cost to attend re|engage is \$60. This cost includes a workbook for both you and your spouse, our celebration dinner, and childcare for all.



relevance - Frequently Asked Questions

What is the origin of relevance? The ministry launched at Watermark Community Church in Dallas, TX, in September 2008 and has since expanded to other churches all over the country.

What does a typical night at relevance look like? Large group with testimony or teaching for the first 30 minutes, followed by up to an hour of small group time.

Will I be asked a lot of personal questions at relevance? There is no personal sharing required during the large group meeting. Though we encourage you to remain active in group discussion, any personal sharing during the small group time is voluntary.

How will I know that what I share at relevance will be kept confidential? Will it be a safe place to share? We believe that scripture calls us to refrain from gossip and we ask all participants and facilitators to adhere to the guidelines that what is discussed in the group stays in the group. Relevance facilitators are encouraged to operate under the direction of God's Word in handling the information shared in the group. In order to provide a safe environment, the facilitators have committed to not share information about others outside the group except in the event of the threat of physical, emotional or spiritual injury, then to be dealt with under the guidance of relevance leadership.

Can I be honest with people about what is going on in my marriage? Our prayer is that you will feel safe to share within your small group. We find that the more authentic and transparent couples can be with others, the more they find hope and healing for their marriage.

Is relevance counseling? Relevance is not marriage counseling, and the leaders are facilitators, not counselors. They are also growing in the own marriages. Everyone in the group is on the journey to oneness in marriage. We believe that openness and honesty in a small group setting, using the Bible's counsel and Biblically-based curriculum, is where God works to grow and even resurrect marriages.

How much time each week outside of the meeting is required to be a part of relevance? Once you're in a closed group, completion of the curriculum will take approximately 20-30 minutes each week, some weeks more, some weeks less.

I don't know if I'll have a marriage by the end of the month. Is relevance a good place for us? Absolutely! There are many couples who have attended relevance who are separated or divorced. While the outcome is based on the work each individual is willing to do to fight for the marriage, the platform provides a safe place to focus on what a healthy marriage should look like, and it provides some tools to help toward this goal.

We don't like spending time with each other anymore. Will we have to interact together? While you will be in a small group together, each of you will be sharing about what you learn personally each week. However, there are several exercises that may require you to interact with each other throughout the process.

I have no hope anymore. Is this a place where we can find hope? Our prayer is that you will find the hope that comes through allowing God to do a mighty work in your marriage.

My marriage is doing well. Can we benefit by attending relevance? Whether your marriage needs to be reignited, or in need of a complete resurrection, relevance is a safe place for couples to reconnect.

We have only been married for 6 months. Can we still come? Absolutely! In fact, participating in relevance at this stage in your marriage is a great idea! The ministry will provide a strong foundation for your marriage.
