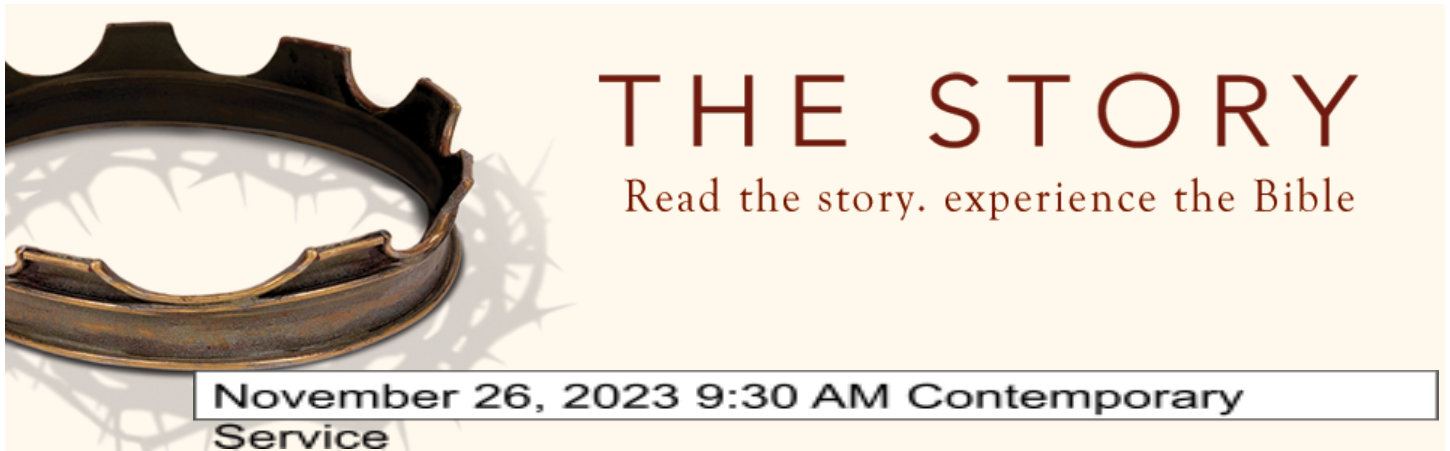

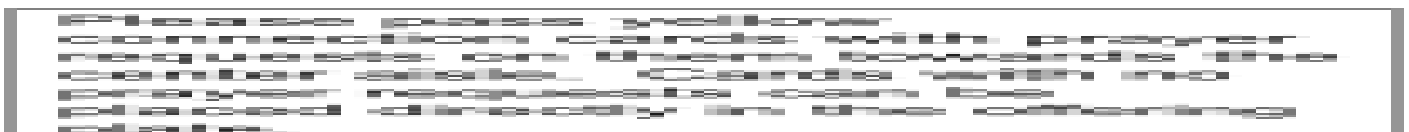

First Fruits Sunday - Update!

A big thank you to our Fellowship Team and to everyone who signed up on Sign Up Genius to bring sides, desserts, and such. The total pledge towards our Generosity Campaign was \$101,850 dollars! GOD IS GOOD, ALL THE TIME! Over \$46,000 has already been received and that doesn't include last Sunday's First Fruit offerings. God is doing amazing things through YOU! It is our hope that all pledges will be received by February 18th, 2024. New pledges are always welcome and may be put in the offering box in the lobby. The Church Council will execute the LED Sign contract as soon as we have the necessary funds from the campaign.
