Easter Lilies

Our Easter lilies are fading fast, so we have removed them from the Sanctuary and moved them to a cart in the Fellowship Hall. If you would like to take them home with you, please do, otherwise we will toss them after this Sunday.

Facility Update

It looks like our LED sign will not be approved by the county until May, and that's the best case scenario. That means, we are looking at an install date around July of this year. We plan to make improvements to our front landscaping and overall curb appeal around this same time. Progress on our Cry Room has also been delayed as we are waiting for approval from the county for this also. We will most likely wait until June or July to replace the platform in our chancel area (what some people call "The Stage.") We don't want to disrupt Sunday services anymore than we need to and there are a few other things we'd like to do in the sanctuary at the same time, so we may wait until our attendance is at its lowest and plan on moving worship to the Fellowship Hall for a Sunday or two in order to get everything done in one shot.

I know these delays are not what we had hoped for, but if all goes according to the schedule above everything will be done just in time for Fall and the return of all our winter friends. Just think of the difference these changes will make to Christ the Victor and our ability to reach out to the community and welcome them into a beautiful sanctuary where they will encounter the love and care of our savior, Jesus Christ!
