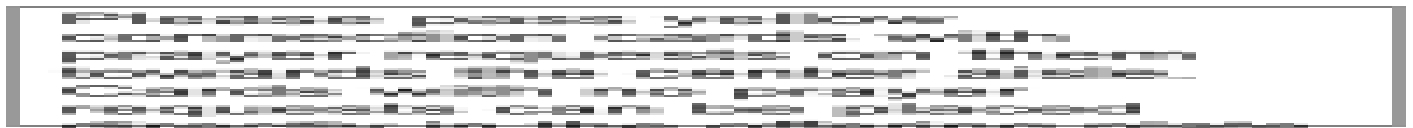

The “Story”: Chapter 2-God Builds a Nation
Text: Genesis 12:1-9

Main Point: In Chapter 2 of the STORY, God begins to build a new nation starting with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. God will use these three patriarchs, who are full of sin and deceit, to reveal Himself and His plan to the world! Throughout the UPPER STORY, God uses ordinary and sinful people to do extraordinary things, reminding us that God can also do extraordinary things through us!
