Dear Trinity Member,

The Faith of a Child



Picture this: Across the pew to your left, a girl is looking at a book about church. She points to the cross on the page and looks up to see the cross above the altar. Two siblings fold their hands and enthusiastically say “Amen!” with everyone else. A boy is sternly shushing his baby sister for whimpering during the Bible reading. These children are all learning what it means to worship in church!

Children undergo incredible changes between the ages of 4 and 6. Specialists sometimes refer to children in this age group as *emerging readers*. This label reflects the major changes in language skills that occur during these years. The ability to identify letters, recognize basic sight words, and sound out longer words are key. In addition to the growth in language skills, children this age see rapid changes in both their gross- and fine-motor skills. They can skip, hop, and balance. They learn to grip a pencil, write letters, and draw shapes. One additional area of growth is developing social skills. Children learn to cooperatively play together and take turns. Children begin to understand the feelings of others and are often preoccupied with rule-following (particularly that others do so!).

Resources for Emerging Readers

Words of Worship includes resources specifically designed for emerging readers, including books, musical resources, and worship aids.

- **Children’s Books:** The books for this age group will take many forms, including traditional picture books, books with buttons to play music and sounds, and books with magnetic pieces for manipulation.
- **Parent Guides:** Targeted booklets will help you answer your child’s questions following the service about the things they see and hear in church.
- **Music Resources:** Many children in this age group love music. Words of Worship music resources will assist and train children to play music, which enhances the worship experience for all ages.

Prepare for Partnership

As you prepare to participate in the *Words of Worship* program, watch for the resources designed especially for children in this important developmental stage.
