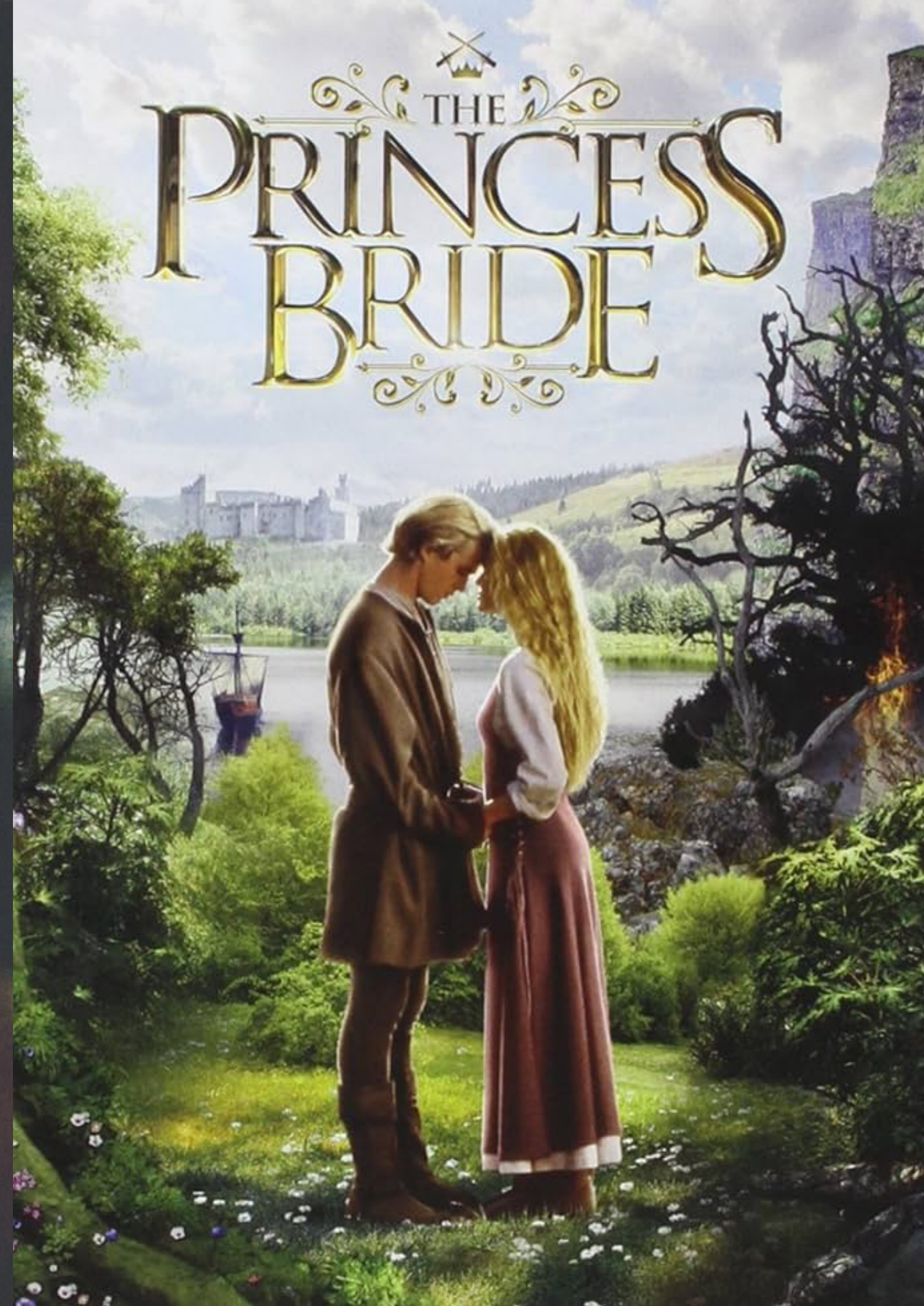

go over to the other side.””



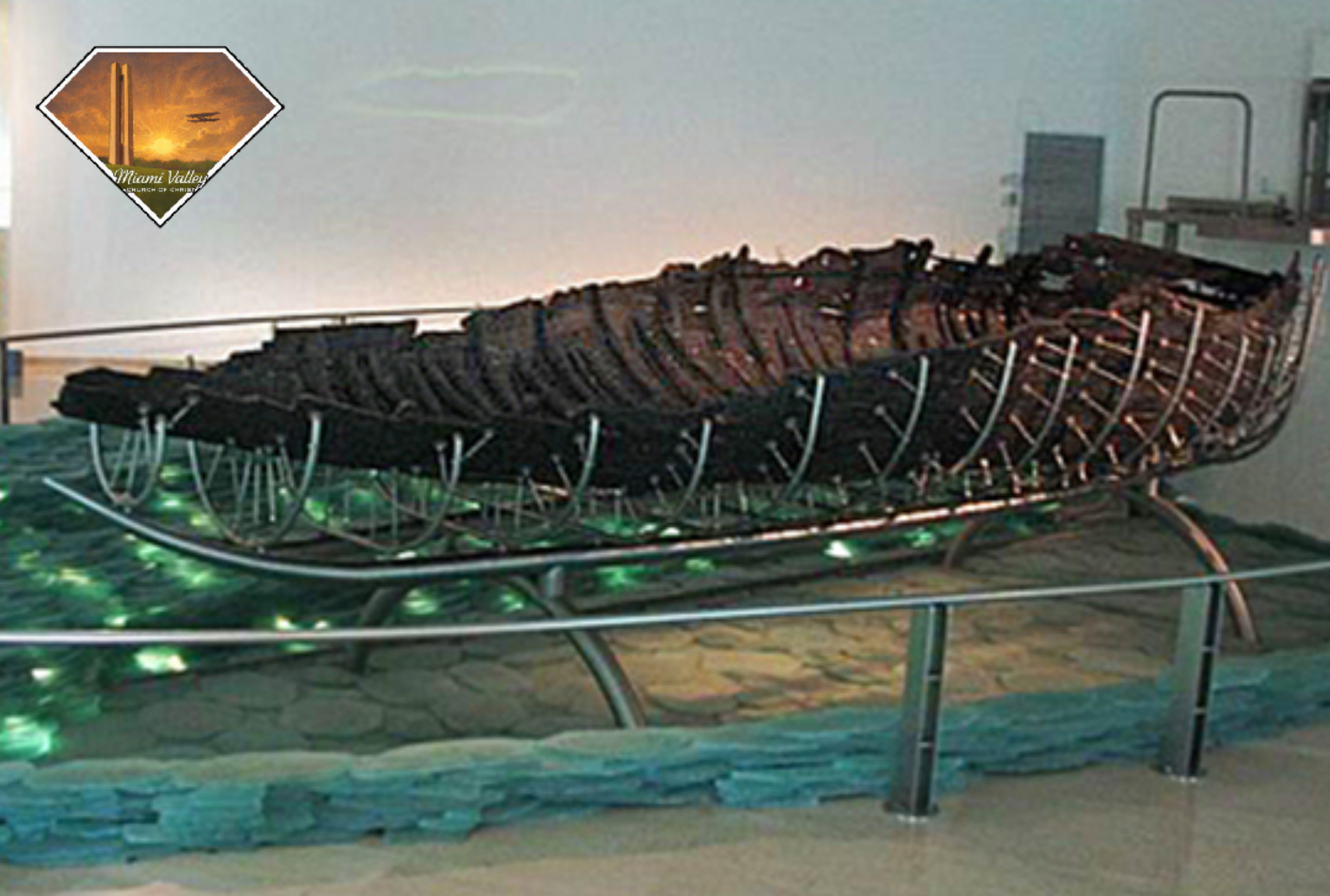
Jesus was with them
